





NRRA School Recycling CLUB

Through our Train the Trainer program, the workshops were presented to teachers in rural areas of NH and VT who agreed to train other teachers. In return, they would receive access to the workshops and curricula reference books. We are pleased to report that over 150 teachers, educators and staff were trained and received these references, along with our Certificate of Appreciation.

NRRA’s School Recycling CLUB is pleased to make available our four workshops and two reference books, **3R’s of the Common Core** and **Teaching Toxics**, to all K-12 schools. These have all been updated and tied to Common Core Standards.
