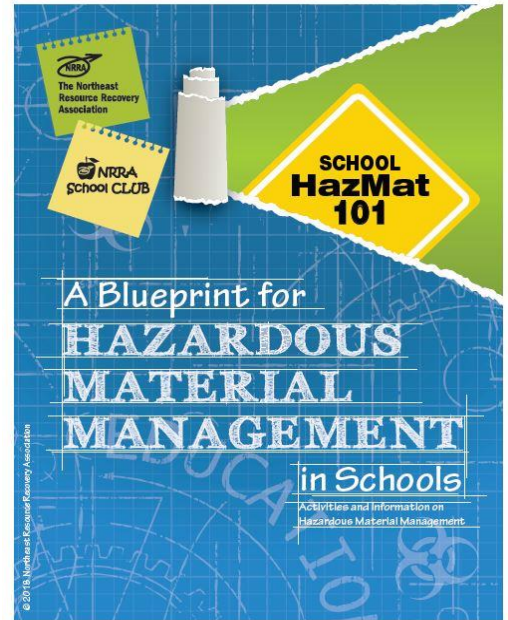


Presenting ... School HazMat 101!

Are you concerned about your school's health and safety? NRRRA's **School HazMat 101: A Blueprint for Hazardous Materials Management in Schools** was written specifically to help the entire school community benefit from addressing hazardous materials use. Funded by the USDA Rural Utilities Program, this manual provides information that improves the school's ability to employ safe management practices.

Many people are accustomed to using hazardous materials in their everyday lives and have become desensitized to the potential health and environmental risks. They also may not fully understand the short and long-term health and environmental consequences. NRRRA's **School HazMat 101: A Blueprint for Hazardous Materials Management in Schools** reveals how hazardous materials can be used safely by raising awareness of the role hazardous materials play in their lives and the associated risks.
